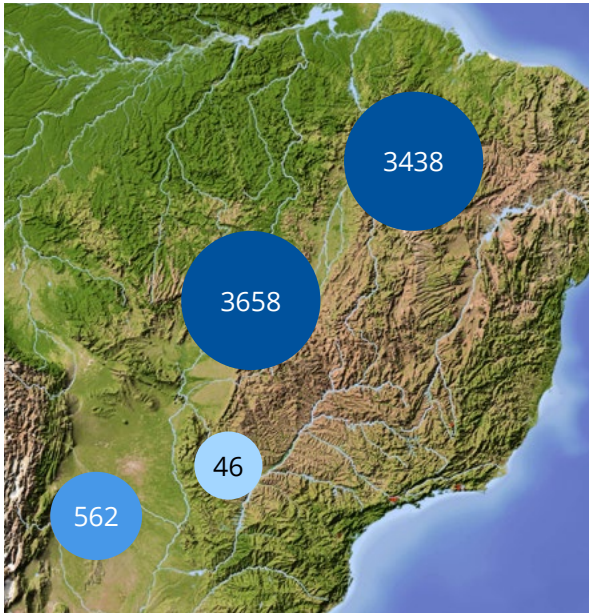

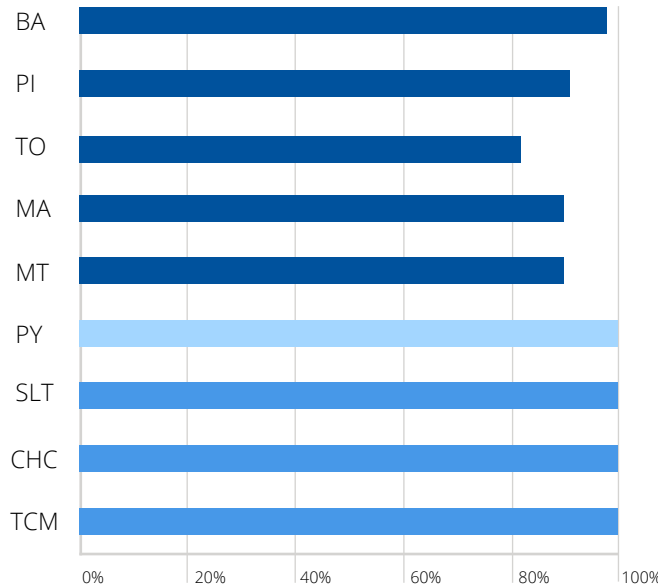


Developing value chains that are transparent, verifiable and contribute to positive impacts on the ground, with the goal of reaching deforestation-free supply chains between 2020-2025.

### SECTOR ENGAGEMENT

In February 2019, the Soft Commodities Forum committed to a [common framework](#) for reporting & monitoring progress on transparent and traceable supply chains for soy in Brazil's Cerrado region. The Cerrado Working Group continues a multi-stakeholder approach to finding a solution for eliminating deforestation from soy supply chains in the Cerrado in the shortest timeframe possible.

### IMPLEMENTING OUR COMMITMENT



In the 2018-19 crop season, we increased the number of monitored farms from 6,770 to 7,726 in Brazil, Argentina and Paraguay.
